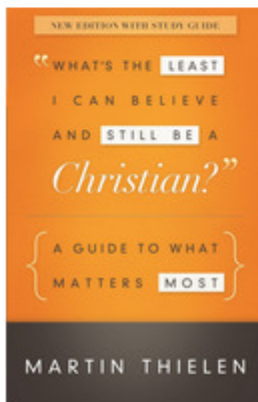




What's the Least I Can Believe ... And Still Be a Christian?



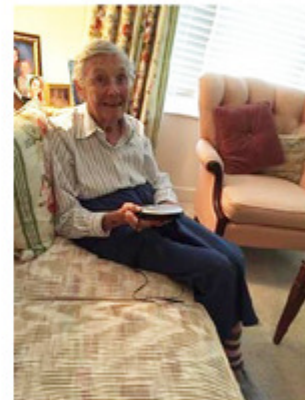
